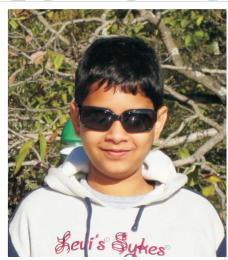


**MANJIS SARKAR MEMORIAL TRUST** has been set up in memory of MANJIS SARKAR -beloved elder son of Manas Sarkar and Swarupa Bandyopadhyay Sarkar . The family lost him in a Road Traffic Accident at the age of 13yrs. On 16<sup>th</sup> October 2010 ( Durga Puja, “Maha Nabami” ) - the family was on a holiday trip – from Kolkata to Benaras. Near the Pareshnath Railway station (under Dumri Police station, Jharkhand, on National Highway-2) a Truck came from the wrong side ignoring all the traffic rules and collided with the car. It was a head -on collision for the car, Manjis's parents became unconscious and brought to the Bokaro General Hospital by the Police and local people. Manjis suffered “ Traumatic Brain Injury “. The unfortunate parents could never able to see their 13 years old elder son. From that day his mother became paraplegic because of spinal Cord Injury.

#### OBJECTS of The Trust

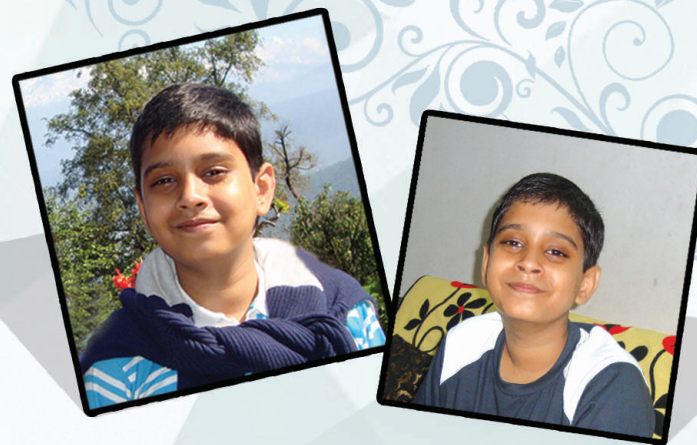

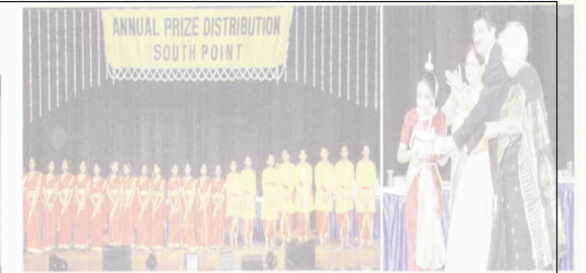
